Lyngblomsten: Monday, March 30, 6:45-7:45 p.m.

Lyngblomsten is at 1415 Almond Avenue in St. Paul, between Snelling and Hamline. Park in the "Lyngblomsten Care Center Visitor Parking" lot on the north side of Almond. Go in the main entrance on the south side of the building, under the large numeral 1415. Go right, walk past the elevators, and turn left to get to the chapel.

Johanna Shores: Monday, April 6, 6:30-7:30 p.m.

Johanna Shores is at 3220 Lake Johanna Boulevard (same street as Fairview Avenue) in Arden Hills, about a half mile north of County Road D. After you turn into the driveway, go left and down the hill into the parking lot. Use the building entrance labeled 3220, at the north end of the parking lot. Once inside, go to the right, walk down the hall, take another right, and you'll see the chapel. A support group will be meeting in the room until 6:00, so we'll need help setting up the stage quickly.

Eagle Crest Arbor: Monday, April 13, 6:00-7:00 p.m.

Eagle Crest Arbor is at 2955 Lincoln Drive in Roseville. It's the northernmost of the Eagle Crest buildings, just south of Lydia Avenue. Take Snelling to Lydia. Go west on Lydia and then south on Lincoln Drive. Take a right into the first driveway and you'll see the building. After someone lets you in, go straight ahead and the performance space will be on the left.

Ramsey County Care Center: Tuesday, April 21, 6:45-7:45 p.m.

Ramsey County Care Center is at 2000 White Bear Avenue in Maplewood. It's about 0.8 miles south of Highway 36 and 0.5 miles north of Larpenteur Avenue, on the east side of White Bear Avenue. After entering the building, take the elevator down one level to get to the performance area. Some players might go to Bleechers Bar & Grill after the concert.
